RECIPE

Blueberry Cake

- 1 1/4 cups plus 1 tsp allpurpose flour, divided
- 2/3 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- · 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 3/4 tsp baking powder
- 3/4 tsp baking soda
- 1/4 tsp kosher salt
- 1 egg
- 1/3 cup olive oil
- 1/2 cup plain Greek Yogurt
- 1/2 cup unsweetened applesauce
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 11/2 cups blueberries
- 1 tsp lemon zest plus 1 tsp lemon juice

Preheat the oven to 350°F. Butter an 8 or 9-inch spring-form pan or round cake pan, then dust it with flour. If using a cake pan, line the bottom with parchment paper. Place the flour, brown sugar, cinnamon, baking powder, baking soda, and salt into a medium bowl and use a fork to thoroughly mix the ingredients together. Use your hands to make a hole in the center of the dry ingredients. Into the hole, crack the egg and add the olive oil, yogurt, applesauce, vanilla, and lemon zest. Use a fork to mix the ingredients together until smooth and blended. In another bowl, mix the blueberries with the lemon juice and 1 tsp flour. Pour the batter into the prepared pan. Sprinkle the blueberries in a single layer on the top (no need to press them down). Bake the cake for 35-40 minutes, until golden brown on top and a toothpick in the center comes out clean. Remove from the oven and leave on the counter to cool completely, about one hour.
